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### Summary Information

**Overview.** The bill removes the requirement that a member of the U.S. Armed Forces, while serving outside of the United States, sign an affidavit to receive certain exemptions from paying motor vehicle taxes and fees.

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## Summary of Legislation

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The bill removes the requirement that a member of the U.S. Armed Forces, while serving outside of the United States, sign an affidavit to receive certain exemptions from paying motor vehicle taxes and fees.

## State Expenditures

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The bill minimally increases workload and expenditures in the Department of Revenue in FY 2026-27 only to perform DRIVES programming to remove the signed affidavit from the list of requirements for exemptions from motor vehicle taxes and fees. This workload can be absorbed with existing resources.

## Effective Date

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The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 20, 2026, and takes effect on August 12, 2026, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
