**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101     **CONCERNING THE USE OF A PERSON'S DRIVER'S HISTORY RECORD TO**  
102         **MAKE DECISIONS THAT CONCERN THE PRACTICE OF AN**  
103         **OCCUPATION.**

**Bill Summary**

The bill limits the time the appropriate regulatory authority in the department of revenue and the department of regulatory agencies may use a driver's history to make certain decisions about a license, permit, certification, or registration that is necessary to practice an occupation or profession or to operate a business.

*Dashes through the words indicate deletions from existing statute.*

The decisions that are limited by the bill concern:

- Issuing, renewing, reinstating, or reactivating the license, permit, certification, or registration; and
- Taking disciplinary action against the holder of the license, permit, certification, or registration.

The events in a driver's history used to make these decisions may be used only if the event occurred within 3 years before:

- The person applied for the license, permit, certification, or registration; or
- The act upon which the discipline is based.

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-20-102, **add** (7.5)

3     as follows:

4           **12-20-102. Definitions.** As used in this title 12, unless the context  
5     otherwise requires:

6           **(7.5) (a)** "DRIVER'S HISTORY" MEANS A DRIVER'S HISTORY RECORD  
7     MADE AND MAINTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 42-2-121 (2).

8           **(b)** "DRIVER'S HISTORY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A MISDEMEANOR OR  
9     FELONY CONVICTION, NOTWITHSTANDING THAT THE CONVICTION IS  
10    INCLUDED WITHIN THE DRIVER'S HISTORY RECORD MADE AND MAINTAINED  
11    IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 42-2-121 (2).

12           **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-20-202, **add** (5.5)  
13     as follows:

14           **12-20-202. Licenses, certifications, and registrations - renewal**  
15    **- reinstatement - fees - occupational credential portability program**  
16    **- temporary authority for military spouses - definitions - exceptions**  
17    **for military personnel - rules - consideration of criminal convictions**  
18    **or driver's history - executive director authority.** (5.5) **Driver's**

21 CERTIFICANT, OR REGISTRANT WHEN DETERMINING:

24 **(III) THE SEVERITY OF DISCIPLINE TO IMPOSE.**

17      (1.5) (a) "DRIVER'S HISTORY" MEANS A DRIVER'S HISTORY RECORD  
18      MADE AND MAINTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 42-2-121 (2).

19      (b) "DRIVER'S HISTORY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A MISDEMEANOR OR  
20      FELONY CONVICTION, NOTWITHSTANDING THAT THE CONVICTION IS  
21      INCLUDED WITHIN THE DRIVER'S HISTORY RECORD MADE AND MAINTAINED  
22      IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 42-2-121 (2).

23      **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 44-1-104 as  
24      follows:

25      **44-1-104. Use of driver's history for professional licensing,**  
26      **permit, or registration decisions.** (1) WHEN A PERSON APPLIES FOR A  
27      LICENSE, PERMIT, OR REGISTRATION UNDER THIS TITLE 44, THE

1 DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT CONSIDER AN EVENT IN THE APPLICANT'S  
2 DRIVER'S HISTORY WHEN DETERMINING WHETHER TO ISSUE TO THE  
3 APPLICANT A NEW, RENEWAL, OR REINSTATED LICENSE, PERMIT, OR  
4 REGISTRATION UNLESS:

5 (a) THE EVENT IS RELEVANT TO THE ETHICS OF OR PERFORMANCE  
6 OF THE PROFESSION OR OCCUPATION THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE  
7 APPLICATION; AND

8 (b) (I) THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IS A DUTY OF THE  
9 PROFESSION OR OCCUPATION THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE APPLICATION;  
10 (II) THE EVENT IS A PART OF A PATTERN OF BEHAVIOR THAT IS

12 OCCUPATION THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE APPLICATION; OR

16 (2) (a) UNLESS SUBSECTION (2)(b) OF THIS SECTION APPLIES, THE  
17 DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT CONSIDER AN EVENT WITHIN THE DRIVER'S  
18 HISTORY OF A LICENSE HOLDER, PERMIT HOLDER, OR REGISTRANT WHEN  
19 DETERMINING:

20 (I) WHETHER TO IMPOSE DISCIPLINE;  
21 (II) THE TYPE OF DISCIPLINE TO IMPOSE; OR  
22 (III) THE SEVERITY OF DISCIPLINE TO IMPOSE.

23 (b) THE DEPARTMENT MAY CONSIDER AN EVENT WITHIN A  
24 DRIVER'S HISTORY IF:

25 (I) THE EVENT IS RELEVANT TO THE ETHICS OF OR PERFORMANCE  
26 OF THE PROFESSION OR OCCUPATION FOR WHICH THE LICENSE HOLDER,  
27 PERMIT HOLDER, OR REGISTRANT IS LICENSED, PERMITTED, OR

1       REGISTERED; AND

2       (II) (A) THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IS A DUTY OF THE  
3       PROFESSION OR OCCUPATION FOR WHICH THE LICENSE HOLDER, PERMIT  
4       HOLDER, OR REGISTRANT IS LICENSED, PERMITTED, OR REGISTERED;

5       (B) THE EVENT IS A PART OF A PATTERN OF BEHAVIOR THAT IS  
6       RELEVANT TO THE ETHICS OF OR PERFORMANCE OF THE PROFESSION OR  
7       OCCUPATION FOR WHICH THE LICENSE HOLDER, PERMIT HOLDER, OR  
8       REGISTRANT IS LICENSED, PERMITTED, OR REGISTERED; OR

9       (C) THE EVENT OCCURRED WITHIN THREE YEARS BEFORE THE ACT  
10      UPON WHICH THE DISCIPLINE IS BASED.

11      **SECTION 6. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
12      takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
13      ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except  
14      that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V  
15      of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this  
16      act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take  
17      effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
18      November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
19      official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
