**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101      **CONCERNING THE RIGHT OF A CONSUMER TO CANCEL AUTOMATIC**  
102      **RENEWAL CONTRACTS ONLINE.**

**Bill Summary**

Under current law, if a consumer consents to an automatic renewal contract for a good or service through an online medium, the person that sells the good or service may provide the consumer with an opportunity to cancel the automatic renewal contract either online or in person.

The bill changes this provision to state that the person that sells the good or service is required to provide the consumer with an opportunity

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 6-1-732, **repeal and**  
3 **reenact, with amendments, (2)(d); and add (1)(d.7), (2.5), and (7)** as  
4 follows:

5           **6-1-732. Automatic renewal contracts - unlawful acts -**  
6 **required disclosures - right to cancel - trial period offers - exemptions**  
7 **- rules - definitions. (1) As used in this section, unless the context**  
8 **otherwise requires:**

9           (d.7) "ONE-STEP ONLINE CANCELLATION" MEANS AN ONLINE  
10 METHOD OF CANCELLATION THAT DOES NOT REQUIRE ADDITIONAL ACTION  
11 FROM THE CONSUMER WHICH OBSTRUCTS OR DELAYS THE CONSUMER'S  
12 ABILITY TO TERMINATE AN AUTOMATIC RENEWAL CONTRACT OR  
13 CONTINUOUS SERVICE IMMEDIATELY.

14           (2) It is unlawful for a person that offers an automatic renewal  
15 contract to a consumer in this state to:

16           (d) FAIL TO PROVIDE A SIMPLE, COST-EFFECTIVE, TIMELY,  
17 EASY-TO-USE, AND READILY ACCESSIBLE MECHANISM FOR CANCELING AN  
18 AUTOMATIC RENEWAL CONTRACT OR TRIAL PERIOD OFFER. A PERSON IS  
19 DEEMED TO COMPLY WITH THIS SUBSECTION (2)(d) IF THE PERSON OFFERS:

20           (I) A ONE-STEP ONLINE CANCELLATION LINK TO A CONSUMER WHO  
21 CONSENTED TO THE AUTOMATIC RENEWAL CONTRACT OR TRIAL PERIOD  
22 OFFER THROUGH A WEBSITE OR OTHER ONLINE MEDIUM OR THROUGH AN  
23 ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION, AND THE ONE-STEP ONLINE CANCELLATION  
24 LINK IS:

25           (A) LOCATED ON THE PERSON'S WEBSITE OR CONTAINED IN AN

1 ELECTRONIC DEVICE OR SERVICE OR AN ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION  
2 MADE TO THE CONSUMER; AND

3 (B) AVAILABLE TO THE CONSUMER IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE  
4 CONSUMER COMPLETES A REASONABLE AUTHENTICATION PROTOCOL USED  
5 SOLELY TO CONFIRM THAT THE CONSUMER IS AUTHORIZED TO MAKE  
6 CHANGES TO THE ACCOUNT; OR

7 (II) ONE OF THE FOLLOWING MEANS OF CANCELING THE  
8 AUTOMATIC RENEWAL CONTRACT TO THE CONSUMER IF THE CONSUMER  
9 CONSENTED TO THE AUTOMATIC RENEWAL CONTRACT OR TRIAL PERIOD  
10 OFFER THROUGH MEANS OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED IN SUBSECTION  
11 (2)(d)(I) OF THIS SECTION:

12 (A) A ONE-STEP ONLINE CANCELLATION LINK THAT IS LOCATED ON  
13 THE PERSON'S WEBSITE OR CONTAINED IN AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE OR  
14 SERVICE OR AN ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION MADE TO THE CONSUMER  
15 AND AVAILABLE TO THE CONSUMER IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CONSUMER  
16 COMPLETES A REASONABLE AUTHENTICATION PROTOCOL USED SOLELY TO  
17 CONFIRM THAT THE CONSUMER IS AUTHORIZED TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE  
18 ACCOUNT; OR

19 (B) AN IN-PERSON MECHANISM FOR CANCELING AN AUTOMATIC  
20 RENEWAL CONTRACT OR TRIAL PERIOD OFFER THAT IS AT A PHYSICAL  
21 LOCATION WHERE THE CONSUMER REGULARLY UTILIZES ANY GOODS OR  
22 SERVICES THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THE AUTOMATIC RENEWAL CONTRACT  
23 AND SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION (2)(d).

24 (2.5) IF A CONSUMER REQUESTS TO CANCEL AN AUTOMATIC  
25 RENEWAL CONTRACT BY AN ONLINE SYSTEM, A PERSON MAY DISPLAY A  
26 DISCOUNTED OFFER, A RETENTION BENEFIT, OR INFORMATION REGARDING  
27 THE EFFECTS OF CANCELLATION IF THE BUSINESS SIMULTANEOUSLY

1 DISPLAYS A PROMINENTLY LOCATED AND CONTINUOUSLY PROXIMATE  
2 DIRECT LINK TO CANCEL ALONGSIDE THE PRESENTATION OF THE  
3 DISCOUNTED OFFER, RETENTION BENEFIT, OR INFORMATION REGARDING  
4 THE EFFECTS OF CANCELLATION. IF THE CONSUMER UTILIZES THE DIRECT  
5 LINK TO CANCEL, THE BUSINESS SHALL PROMPTLY PROCESS THE  
6 CANCELLATION AND SHALL NOT OTHERWISE OBSTRUCT OR DELAY THE  
7 CONSUMER'S REQUEST TO CANCEL.

8 (7) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY ADOPT RULES AS NECESSARY  
9 FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING AND ENFORCING THIS SECTION.

10 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -**  
11 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following  
12 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the  
13 general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant  
14 to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an  
15 item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item,  
16 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the  
17 general election to be held in November 2026 and, in such case, will take  
18 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the  
19 governor.

20 (2) This act applies to automatic renewal contracts offered or  
21 renewed on or after the applicable effective date of this act.
