After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB26-060 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, lines 8 and 9, strike "YOUTH CONCUSSION
- 2 MENTAL HEALTH PROTECTION ACT"." and substitute "YOUTH CONCUSSION
- 3 AND MENTAL HEALTH PROTECTION ACT" OR "ALYSSA'S ACT".

- 4 Page 2, line 21, strike "AN ANNUAL" and substitute "A BIENNIAL".

- 5 Page 3, line 14, after "ABUSE;" insert "AND".

- 6 Page 3, line 15, strike "PREVENTION; AND" and substitute "PREVENTION".

- 7 Page 3, strike lines 16 through 18.

- 8 Page 3, strike lines 26 and 27.

- 9 Page 4, strike lines 1 through 5 and substitute:
- 10 "(3) IF A YOUTH ATHLETE IS REMOVED FROM PLAY FOR A
- 11 SUSPECTED CONCUSSION, THE YOUTH ATHLETE'S COACH OR THE CLUB'S,
- 12 LEAGUE'S, OR PUBLIC RECREATION FACILITY'S OTHER DESIGNATED
- 13 PERSONNEL SHALL NOTIFY THE ATHLETE'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN
- 14 AND ADVISE THAT THE ATHLETE SEEK EVALUATION FROM A LICENSED
- 15 HEALTH-CARE PROVIDER FOR APPROPRIATE MEDICAL AND BEHAVIORAL
- 16 HEALTH GUIDANCE REGARDING POTENTIAL PHYSICAL, COGNITIVE, OR
- 17 PSYCHOLOGICAL SYMPTOMS ASSOCIATED WITH A CONCUSSION."

- 18 Page 4, after line 12 insert:

- 19 "(5) AN ATHLETIC COACH OF A YOUTH ATHLETIC ACTIVITY WHO

1 ACTS IN GOOD FAITH TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS PART
2 2 IS NOT SUBJECT TO CIVIL LIABILITY FOR ANY ACT OR OMISSION RELATED
3 TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS PART 2 UNLESS THE ACT OR OMISSION
4 CONSTITUTES GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL AND WANTON
5 MISCONDUCT.".
