Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB26-141 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 23, after line 8 insert:

2 **"SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2026-27 state fiscal
3 year, \$53,516 is appropriated to the department of revenue for use by the
4 division of motor vehicles. This appropriation is from the DRIVES cash
5 fund created in section 42-1-211 (2)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the
6 division may use this appropriation as follows:

- 7 (a) \$39,782 for DRIVES maintenance and support;
8 (b) \$3,403 for use by the division of motor vehicles for personal
9 services related to vehicle services;
10 (c) \$4,715 for use by the executive director's office for personal
11 services related to administration and support; and
12 (d) \$5,616 for payments to OIT.

13 (2) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$778 is appropriated to the
14 department of natural resources for use by the division of parks and
15 wildlife. This appropriation is from the parks and outdoor recreation cash
16 fund created in section 33-10-111 (1), C.R.S. To implement this act, the
17 division may use this appropriation for state park operations.

18 (3) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$778 is appropriated to the
19 department of revenue for use by the division of motor vehicles. This
20 appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the department
21 of natural resources under subsection (2) of this section. To implement
22 this act, the division may use this appropriation to for DRIVES
23 maintenance and support.

24 (4) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$19,940 is appropriated to
25 the department of law. This appropriation is from the legal services cash
26 fund created in section 24-31-108 (4), C.R.S., from revenue received
27 from the department of transportation that is continuously appropriated

1 to the department of transportation from the collision prevention fund
2 created in section 43-4-805 (3.5)(a), C.R.S. The appropriation to the
3 department of law is based on an assumption that the department of law
4 will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the department
5 of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the
6 department of transportation."

7 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

8 Page 1, line 105, strike "**IMPROVEMENTS.**" and substitute
9 "**IMPROVEMENTS AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**"
