After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB26-1422 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 14, strike lines 21 through 24 and substitute  
2 "statement required in subsection (2)(a) of this section, and the secretary  
3 of state must make all disclosure statements available to the public on its  
4 website. The secretary ~~may~~ SHALL redact ~~certain information such as a~~  
5 candidate's address ~~or~~ AND other personal information BEFORE MAKING A  
6 DISCLOSURE STATEMENT AVAILABLE ON THE SECRETARY'S WEBSITE. THE  
7 SECRETARY MAY ALSO MODIFY THE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FORM TO  
8 ELIMINATE THE INCLUSION OF CERTAIN PERSONAL INFORMATION."
- 9 Page 15, strike lines 11 and 12 and substitute "made available on the  
10 secretary of state's website. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL REDACT THE  
11 ADDRESS AND OTHER PERSONAL INFORMATION OF AN INDIVIDUAL  
12 SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION BEFORE POSTING THE  
13 DISCLOSURE STATEMENT ON THE SECRETARY'S WEBSITE. THE SECRETARY  
14 OF STATE MAY ALSO MODIFY THE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FORM TO  
15 ELIMINATE THE INCLUSION OF CERTAIN PERSONAL INFORMATION."
- 16 Page 26, line 21, strike "REMAINING".
