After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB26-1033 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Finance with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 6, strike "and (11)".
- 2 Page 2, line 8, strike "**rules - repeal.**" and substitute "**rules.**"
- 3 Page 4, strike lines 1 through 4 and substitute "SECTION:
4 (A) HAS BEEN FEDERALLY INSPECTED AND BEARS THE MARK OF
5 INSPECTION; OR
6 (B) SATISFIES AN EXEMPTION FROM INSPECTION, SUCH AS A
7 FEDERAL OR STATE EXEMPTION FOR A POULTRY PRODUCER."
- 8 Page 6, strike lines 6 through 11 and substitute "suspected in an injury or
9 food-borne illness outbreak.
10 (b) IF A CONSUMER COMPLAINT OF FOOD-BORNE ILLNESS HAS BEEN
11 RECEIVED, OR IF A PRODUCT IS SUSPECTED IN AN INJURY OR FOOD-BORNE
12 ILLNESS OUTBREAK, THE DEPARTMENT OR A COUNTY, DISTRICT, OR
13 REGIONAL HEALTH AGENCY MAY IMPLEMENT LOCAL RESPONSE
14 PROCEDURES, INCLUDING CORRECTIVE ACTION PLANS, ADDITIONAL FOOD
15 SAMPLING TESTS, AND ADDITIONAL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE
16 PRODUCER. THE DEPARTMENT OR A COUNTY, DISTRICT, OR REGIONAL
17 HEALTH AGENCY MAY CHARGE A PRODUCER ONLY THE DIRECT COSTS
18 INCURRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION (4)(b)."
- 19 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.
- 20 Page 8, strike lines 5 through 16.
- 21 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

1 Page 10, after line 17 insert:

2 **"SECTION 8. Effective date.** This act takes effect upon passage;
3 except that section 25-4-1614, Colorado Revised Statutes, amended in
4 section 2 of this act, and section 35-36-102, Colorado Revised Statutes,
5 amended in section 6 of this act, take effect January 1, 2027."

6 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

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
