After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB26-152 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, line 11, after "(4.6)(b)," insert  
2 "(4.6)(d)(I),".

3 Page 7, line 3, after "SOLD" insert "OR LEASED".

4 Page 7, line 6, strike "SOLD" and substitute "SOLD, LEASED,".

5 Page 15, after line 11 insert:

6           "(d) (I) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION IN THIS  
7 SECTION, the state, a county, a city and county, a school district, or a  
8 municipality that has installed an automated vehicle identification system  
9 on a school bus to detect a motor vehicle overtaking a stopped school bus  
10 shall not use any portion of a fine collected through the use of such  
11 system as the basis for payment to the manufacturer or vendor of the  
12 automated vehicle identification system equipment. The compensation  
13 paid by the state, county, city and county, school district, or municipality  
14 for such equipment must be based upon the value of any equipment or  
15 services provided and must not be based exclusively upon the number of  
16 traffic citations issued or the revenue generated by the automated vehicle  
17 identification system equipment."

18 Page 15, line 18, strike "AND RELATED".

19 Page 15, line 19, strike "SERVICES".

20 Page 16, line 3, strike "OR INDIRECTLY".
