After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB21-166 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 5, line 25, strike "firefighters" and substitute "firefighters" EMERGENCY RESPONDER PERSONNEL".

- 3 Page 7, strike lines 2 through 27.
- 4 Page 8, strike line 1.
- 5 Rerumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 6 Page 10, line 13, strike "FOUR ROUGHLY EQUAL".
- 7 Page 10, line 25, strike "INTRA-AGENCY" and substitute "INTERAGENCY".
- 8 Page 10, strike lines 26 and 27 and substitute:
9 "(III) COORDINATING WITH THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY
10 MANAGEMENT CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-705(1) TO ENSURE EFFICIENT
11 AND EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION AND INTEGRATION OF THE
12 MOBILIZATION PLAN REQUIRED BY SECTION 24-33.5-705.4 (3)(a) AND
13 OTHER STATE AND LOCAL EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLANS, AS
14 APPROPRIATE.".
- 15 Page 11, line 6, strike "REGION;" and substitute "REGION AND ENSURING
16 THE INVENTORY IS INCLUDED IN THE MOBILIZATION SYSTEM DESCRIBED IN
17 SECTION 24-33.5-705.4;".



1 Page 11, line 15, strike "OF" and substitute "WITH".

2 Page 13, after line 9 insert:

3 "**SECTION 6.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-705.4,
4 **amend** (3)(a); and **add** (3)(a.3) and (3)(a.5) as follows:

5 **24-33.5-705.4. All-hazards resource mobilization system -**
6 **creation - plan - duties - reimbursement for expenses incurred by**
7 **mobilized entities - eligibility - resource mobilization fund - creation**
8 **- definitions - legislative declaration.** (3) **Powers and duties.** (a) The
9 director, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF FIRE
10 PREVENTION AND CONTROL IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY
11 CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-1201 (1)(a), shall develop and maintain a
12 statewide all-hazards resource mobilization plan that sets forth procedures
13 for mobilization, allocation, deployment, coordination, tracking, cost
14 accounting, and demobilization of resources during disasters and other
15 large-scale emergencies and local incidents that require more resources
16 than those available under any existing interjurisdictional or mutual aid
17 agreement. In developing the mobilization plan, the director shall consult
18 with and solicit recommendations from the homeland security and
19 all-hazards senior advisory committee created in section 24-33.5-1614
20 and other appropriate representatives of state, tribal, and local
21 governmental and private sector emergency management organizations.
22 The director shall ensure that the mobilization plan is consistent with, and
23 incorporated into, the Colorado state comprehensive emergency
24 management program described in section 24-33.5-705 (2) AND THE
25 COLORADO COORDINATED REGIONAL AND STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID
26 SYSTEM CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-1235 (3).

27 (a.3) THE DIRECTOR SHALL ENSURE THAT RESOURCES IN THE
28 COLORADO COORDINATED REGIONAL AND STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID
29 SYSTEM CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-1235 (3)(a) ARE INCLUDED IN THE
30 ALL-HAZARDS RESOURCE MOBILIZATION SYSTEM DESCRIBED IN THIS
31 SECTION.

32 (a.5) THE DIRECTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE STATE
33 COORDINATION CENTER CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-1235 (3)(b) TO
34 ENSURE SUFFICIENT AND EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION AND INTEGRATION
35 OF THE RESOURCE MOBILIZATION PLAN REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (3)(a)
36 OF THIS SECTION AND STATE AND LOCAL EMERGENCE OPERATIONS PLANS,
37 AS APPROPRIATE.".
