

Be it enacted by the People of the state of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Constitution, Article V, Section 1, **add** (5.6) as follows:

(5.6) BALLOT QUESTIONS MUST BE IN PLAIN LANGUAGE AT NO MORE THAN AN EIGHTH GRADE READING LEVEL AND MAY NOT EXCEED ONE HUNDRED WORDS. NO STATUTE MAY INTERFERE WITH THIS PROVISION BY MANDATING LANGUAGE PRECEDING, FOLLOWING OR IN A BALLOT TITLE OF AN INITIATIVE.
