Fiscal Summary of Initiative 235

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. State Expenditures

The measure requires all ballot questions to be in plain language and written at an eighth-grade reading level. There may be increased workload for the Title Board in the Department of State, the Colorado Judicial Department, or the General Assembly to make determinations on the standards for plain language and an eighth-grade reading level.

Economic Impacts

While this measure may impact how future ballot questions are presented to voters, the initiative itself is not expected to have a direct economic impact on the state.
