

AMPLIFY Act: Veteran and Reintegration Support

Legislating drafter file. This chapter draft is designed to stand on its own and to support modular insertion into broader AMPLIFY stacks.

Bill 28. AMPLIFY Act: Veteran and Reintegration Support

Single subject. Transition and access supports for veterans and returning citizens facing automated exclusion or displacement.

Purpose. Provide targeted support for groups likely to face gatekeeping or reintegration barriers.

Draft structure

Section	Core draft direction
1. Short title	This act shall be known and may be cited as the “AMPLIFY Act: Veteran and Reintegration Support”.
2. Legislative declaration	The general assembly finds and declares that provide targeted support for groups likely to face gatekeeping or reintegration barriers.
3. Definitions	Definitions should be alphabetized, lowercase, and drafted in singular form unless a term of art requires otherwise.
4. Operative sections	Substantive rights, duties, approvals, or restrictions listed below.
5. Administration	Rulemaking, designation of administering authority, records, notices, and implementation mechanics.
6. Construction	Independent operation, severability, no implied repeal, and other necessary construction clauses.
7. Effective date	Effective date and any conditional clause required by filing strategy.

Draft definitions

returning citizen. a person reentering civil life after incarceration or formal correctional custody.

priority support. a support, referral, or placement priority established by law or rule.

Draft operative provisions

Section 4. Program support

- A designated program may provide priority transition support, advocacy, referrals, or challenge assistance to veterans and returning citizens within classes identified by law or rule.
- The program may coordinate with workforce, legal access, and screening-review supports authorized by companion acts.

Section 5. Construction

- This act shall be construed to reduce automated exclusion and reintegration barriers for covered participants.

Required construction clauses

- Independent operation. This act operates independently and remains effective whether or not any related measure or companion act is adopted.
- Severability. If any provision of this act or its application is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.
- Single-subject construction. This act shall be construed to embrace only the single subject described in its title and no separate subject shall be inferred from a remedy, definition, recordkeeping duty, funding mechanism, or construction clause that is necessarily and properly connected to that subject.
