

AMPLIFY Act: Public Accountability Dashboard and Open Data

Legislating Drafter Working Package — 33-bill modular AMPLIFY build

Legislating drafter file. This chapter draft is designed to stand on its own and to support modular insertion into broader AMPLIFY stacks.

Bill 9. AMPLIFY Act: Public Accountability Dashboard and Open Data

Single subject. Public reporting, dashboards, registries, and open data concerning operator compliance and system performance.

Purpose. Give the framework a public transparency layer.

Draft structure

Section	Core draft direction
1. Short title	This act shall be known and may be cited as the “AMPLIFY Act: Public Accountability Dashboard and Open Data”.
2. Legislative declaration	The general assembly finds and declares that give the framework a public transparency layer.
3. Definitions	Definitions should be alphabetized, lowercase, and drafted in singular form unless a term of art requires otherwise.
4. Operative sections	Substantive rights, duties, approvals, or restrictions listed below.
5. Administration	Rulemaking, designation of administering authority, records, notices, and implementation mechanics.
6. Construction	Independent operation, severability, no implied repeal, and other necessary construction clauses.
7. Effective date	Effective date and any conditional clause required by filing strategy.

Draft definitions

dashboard. a public reporting interface required by this act.

open public data. nonconfidential data approved for public release.

pattern database. an anonymized aggregate record of reportable violation patterns or enforcement-relevant events.

Draft operative provisions

Section 4. Dashboard

- The administering authority shall publish a public accountability dashboard showing the information required by law or rule regarding operator compliance, program performance, and public reporting metrics.
- Confidential or resident-specific protected information may not be disclosed except as authorized by law.

Section 5. Pattern database

- The state may maintain an anonymized aggregate pattern database to identify repeated or clustered compliance concerns and may use the database to inform enforcement referrals or policy updates.

Section 6. Open data and api access

- The administering authority may publish approved open public data feeds and interfaces to improve public oversight, research, and interoperability.

Required construction clauses

- Independent operation. This act operates independently and remains effective whether or not any related measure or companion act is adopted.
- Severability. If any provision of this act or its application is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.
- Single-subject construction. This act shall be construed to embrace only the single subject described in its title and no separate subject shall be inferred from a remedy, definition, recordkeeping duty, funding mechanism, or construction clause that is necessarily and properly connected to that subject.
