Legislating drafter file. This chapter draft is designed to stand on its own and to support modular insertion into broader AMPLIFY stacks.

Bill 15. AMPLIFY Act: Proceeding Transparency Portal

Single subject. Resident access to records and updates in active government proceedings.

Purpose. Give people access to the records being used against or about them.

Draft structure

Section	Core draft direction
1. Short title	This act shall be known and may be cited as the “AMPLIFY Act: Proceeding Transparency Portal”.
2. Legislative declaration	The general assembly finds and declares that give people access to the records being used against or about them.
3. Definitions	Definitions should be alphabetized, lowercase, and drafted in singular form unless a term of art requires otherwise.
4. Operative sections	Substantive rights, duties, approvals, or restrictions listed below.
5. Administration	Rulemaking, designation of administering authority, records, notices, and implementation mechanics.
6. Construction	Independent operation, severability, no implied repeal, and other necessary construction clauses.
7. Effective date	Effective date and any conditional clause required by filing strategy.

Draft definitions

active government proceeding. a dependency, criminal, parole, probation, benefits, administrative, or similar proceeding involving the resident and a public body.

proceeding portal. a resident-facing portal for records and updates authorized by this act.

Draft operative provisions

Section 4. Portal access

- An administering authority may create a proceeding portal for active government proceedings within classes designated by law or rule.
- Where implemented, the portal shall provide timely access to records, updates, and status information to the extent authorized by law.

Section 5. Updates

- The administering authority shall seek frequent updates and resident-readable records for participating proceeding classes.

Section 6. Confidentiality

- Protected, sealed, or otherwise restricted material shall be treated in accordance with governing law.

Required construction clauses

- Independent operation. This act operates independently and remains effective whether or not any related measure or companion act is adopted.
- Severability. If any provision of this act or its application is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.
- Single-subject construction. This act shall be construed to embrace only the single subject described in its title and no separate subject shall be inferred from a remedy, definition, recordkeeping duty, funding mechanism, or construction clause that is necessarily and properly connected to that subject.
