Bill 13. AMPLIFY Act: Digital Identity Restoration

Single subject. Identity restoration claims, funds, and services for verified digital harms.

Purpose. Provide concrete recovery pathways for residents harmed by digital misuse.

Draft structure

Section	Core draft direction
1. Short title	This act shall be known and may be cited as the “AMPLIFY Act: Digital Identity Restoration”.
2. Legislative declaration	The general assembly finds and declares that provide concrete recovery pathways for residents harmed by digital misuse.
3. Definitions	Definitions should be alphabetized, lowercase, and drafted in singular form unless a term of art requires otherwise.
4. Operative sections	Substantive rights, duties, approvals, or restrictions listed below.
5. Administration	Rulemaking, designation of administering authority, records, notices, and implementation mechanics.
6. Construction	Independent operation, severability, no implied repeal, and other necessary construction clauses.
7. Effective date	Effective date and any conditional clause required by filing strategy.

Draft definitions

restoration claim. a claim seeking identity restoration services, reimbursement, or other remedial support after a verified digital harm.

restoration service. a service reasonably designed to correct, mitigate, or reverse a covered identity-related harm.

Draft operative provisions

Section 4. Fund and claims

- A restoration fund may receive money lawfully allocated for identity restoration.
- An administering authority shall establish a process for receiving, reviewing, and resolving restoration claims.

Section 5. Priority and timing

- Minor-related claims and acute identity harms may receive priority processing under rules established by the administering authority.
- The administering authority shall seek prompt resolution of verified restoration claims.

Section 6. Eligible support

- Restoration services may include correction support, takedown support, verification assistance, legal referrals, and other services authorized by rule.

Required construction clauses

- Independent operation. This act operates independently and remains effective whether or not any related measure or companion act is adopted.
- Severability. If any provision of this act or its application is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.
- Single-subject construction. This act shall be construed to embrace only the single subject described in its title and no separate subject shall be inferred from a remedy, definition, recordkeeping duty, funding mechanism, or construction clause that is necessarily and properly connected to that subject.
