Bill 11. AMPLIFY Act: Digital Enforcement and Remedies

Single subject. Civil enforcement, corrective action, and remedies for violations of amplify protections.

Purpose. Create the main remedies bill.

Draft structure

Section	Core draft direction
1. Short title	This act shall be known and may be cited as the “AMPLIFY Act: Digital Enforcement and Remedies”.
2. Legislative declaration	The general assembly finds and declares that create the main remedies bill.
3. Definitions	Definitions should be alphabetized, lowercase, and drafted in singular form unless a term of art requires otherwise.
4. Operative sections	Substantive rights, duties, approvals, or restrictions listed below.
5. Administration	Rulemaking, designation of administering authority, records, notices, and implementation mechanics.
6. Construction	Independent operation, severability, no implied repeal, and other necessary construction clauses.
7. Effective date	Effective date and any conditional clause required by filing strategy.

Draft definitions

corrective action. a required remediation step ordered by an authorized enforcing body.

digital soul interference. unauthorized misuse, obstruction, falsification, or defeat of protected digital interests or recognized control signals.

enforcing authority. the attorney general, designated agency, or other body authorized by law.

Draft operative provisions

Section 4. Enforcement authority

- An enforcing authority may investigate alleged violations of this act and companion acts and may seek corrective action, injunctive relief, civil remedies, or other relief authorized by law.

Section 5. Corrective action

- A corrective action order may require cessation of an unlawful practice, restoration of a resident-facing control, implementation of required logging, or other targeted remedial action.

Section 6. Construction

- This act shall be construed to preserve effective resident remedies and to prevent compliance theater from substituting for actual correction.

Required construction clauses

- Independent operation. This act operates independently and remains effective whether or not any related measure or companion act is adopted.
- Severability. If any provision of this act or its application is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.
- Single-subject construction. This act shall be construed to embrace only the single subject described in its title and no separate subject shall be inferred from a remedy, definition, recordkeeping duty, funding mechanism, or construction clause that is necessarily and properly connected to that subject.
