RE: OSPB Submission of Prioritized FY 2016-17 Capital Construction Supplemental Requests and FY 2017-18 Capital Construction Budget Amendments

Dear Representative Esgar:

As required by § 24-37-304 (1) (c.3) (III), C.R.S., we are pleased to submit the Governor's Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revised prioritization of capital construction requests for FY 2016-17 and FY 2017-18.

Our prioritization reflects the addition of three projects to be paid from the Capital Construction Fund in FY 2016-17:

- \$355,452 to modify the Lebanon Mill Dam project associated with the Georgetown Loop Railroad;
- \$235,109 to modify a project within the Department of Human Services for suicide risk mitigation at the mental health institute; and
- \$1,351,599 for the replacement of the cooling system in the Capitol Annex at 1373 Sherman St.

In addition, OSPB has prioritized three projects for Colorado State University at the National Western Complex. Per the provisions of H.B. 15-1344, these projects were expected to commence no earlier than July 2019, but CSU has indicated that it would like to begin construction on these facilities on an accelerated schedule. As a first step in accelerating these projects, OSPB is required to prioritize them as part of its regular submission to the CDC pursuant to § 24-37-304, C.R.S. Our prioritization of these projects reflects our support for CSU's efforts to begin these projects as early as July 2017. We have not set aside funding for any payments related to these projects in FY 2017-18, however, and we believe that a change to existing statute is necessary in order for them to proceed at any time before July 2019.

Finally, the attached documentation reflects updated estimates of available revenue in the Capital Construction Fund based on OSPB's December 2016 revenue forecast, changes to interest



earnings available for expenditure, and an accounting of reversions from projects funded in prior years. When combined with projects requested through the Joint Technology Committee, funding for this total package of capital construction requests would require a transfer from the General Fund of \$85.1 million in FY 2017-18.
