Revisor of Statutes:

Pursuant to \$39-22-1001(8)(b), C.R.S., the Department of Revenue hereby advises the Revisor of Statutes that the 2018 Colorado Individual Income Tax Return shall provide no more than 20 lines for voluntary contributions to the following charitable organizations. The following list represents all voluntary contribution funds to appear on the 2018 Individual Income Tax Return:

Three of the voluntary contribution funds that were included on the 2017 Individual Income Tax Return will not appear on the 2018 Individual Income Tax Return due to statutory requirements: Public Education Fund, Colorado for Healthy Landscapes Fund, and Colorado Youth Corps Association Fund. One new voluntary contribution fund will be added to the 2018 Individual Income Tax Return: Young Americans Financial Education Fund. One open line will be reserved for future use.
