4 "(4) THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ALLOCATE 5 TO THE GOVERNING BOARDS OF THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION 6 PARTICIPATING IN ACTIVITIES RELATED TO CYBERSECURITY AND 7 DISTRIBUTED LEDGER TECHNOLOGIES, SUCH AS BLOCKCHAINS, MONEY 8 APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION BY THE 9 GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 AND FOR EACH FISCAL 10 YEAR THEREAFTER.".

3 **SECTION 8.** Appropriation. For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, 4 \$5,000,000 is appropriated to the office of the governor for use by the 5 office of information technology. This appropriation is from the general 6 fund and is based on an assumption that the office of information 7 technology will require an additional 1.0 FTE. To implement this act, the 8 office of information technology may use this appropriation for security 9 governance.

10 (2) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$4,800,000 is appropriated 11 to the department of higher education. This appropriation is from the 12 general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this 13 appropriation for the college opportunity fund program to be used for 14 limited purpose fee-for-service contracts with state institutions.

(3) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$4,800,000 is appropriated
to the department of higher education. This appropriation is from
reappropriated funds received from the limited purpose fee-for-service
contracts with state institutions under subsection (2) of this section. To
implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:
