Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB19-1090 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the House Finance Committee Report, dated March 4, 2019, page
2 38, after line 31 insert:

3 **"SECTION 23. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal
4 year, \$54,766 is appropriated to the department of revenue. This
5 appropriation is from the marijuana cash fund created in section 44-11-
6 501 (1)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this
7 appropriation as follows:

8 (a) \$23,677 for marijuana enforcement, which amount is based on
9 an assumption that the department will require an additional 0.2 FTE;

10 (b) \$31,089 for the purchase of legal services.

11 (2) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$31,089 is appropriated to
12 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
13 received from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(b) of this
14 section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will
15 require an additional 0.2 FTE. To implement this act, the department of
16 law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the
17 department of revenue.

18 **SECTION 24. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal
19 year, \$2,728,795 is appropriated to the department of revenue. This
20 appropriation is from the marijuana cash fund created in section 44-11-
21 501 (1)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this
22 appropriation as follows:

23 (a) \$2,440,779 for marijuana enforcement, which amount is based

1 on an assumption that the department will require an additional 15.5 FTE;
2 (b) \$2,000 for tax administration IT system (GenTax) support;
3 (c) \$242,494 for the purchase of legal services;
4 (d) \$18,772 for the purchase of criminal history record checks;
5 and
6 (e) \$24,750 for vehicle lease payments.
7 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$242,494 is appropriated to
8 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
9 received from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(c) of this
10 section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will
11 require an additional 1.3 FTE. To implement this act, the department of
12 law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the
13 department of revenue.
14 (3) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$18,772 is appropriated to
15 the department of public safety for use by the biometric identification and
16 records unit. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received
17 from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(d) of this section.
18 To implement this act, the unit may use this appropriation to provide
19 criminal history record checks for the department of revenue.
20 (4) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$24,750 is appropriated to
21 the department of personnel. This appropriation is from reappropriated
22 funds received from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(e) of
23 this section. To implement this act, the department of personnel may use
24 this appropriation to provide vehicles for the department of revenue."
