After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB19-019 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 15, after "ENTITY," insert "LOCALIZED
2 EVIDENCE OF LOW FUEL MOISTURE CONTENT,".

3 Page 3, line 6, strike "section;" and substitute:

4 "section. HOWEVER, IF THE COUNTY ADOPTS A RESOLUTION SPECIFYING
5 THAT THE ORDINANCE REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR SUCH PERIOD, OR ANY
6 PORTION OF SUCH PERIOD, AND SUBSEQUENT TO THE ADOPTION OF THE
7 RESOLUTION, A CHANGE IN THE WEATHER OCCURS RESULTING IN
8 COMPETENT EVIDENCE THAT THE HIGH FIRE DANGER IS NOT PRESENT AND
9 NO LONGER WILL BE PRESENT DURING THE REMAINDER OF THE PERIOD, THE
10 COUNTY SHALL ENDEAVOR TO PROMPTLY CONSIDER WHETHER TO
11 EXERCISE ITS LEGISLATIVE DISCRETION TO RESCIND THE RESTRICTIONS IT
12 HAS ADOPTED ON THE SALE, USE, AND POSSESSION OF FIREWORKS.
13 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBSECTION (1)(n.7),
14 THE ORDINANCE REMAINS IN EFFECT AND IS FULLY ENFORCEABLE UNTIL
15 THE RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN RESCINDED."
