

1 (II) BUILT FOR THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES.

2 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-14.5-101, **amend**
3 the introductory portion and (3) introductory portion; and **repeal** (3)(c) as
4 follows:

5 **33-14.5-101. Definitions.** As used in this ~~article~~ ARTICLE 14.5,
6 unless the context otherwise requires:

7 (3) "Off-highway vehicle" means any self-propelled vehicle ~~which~~
8 THAT is designed to travel on wheels or tracks in contact with the ground,
9 ~~which~~ is designed primarily for use off of the public highways, and ~~which~~
10 is generally and commonly used to transport persons for recreational
11 purposes. "OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE" INCLUDES SURPLUS MILITARY
12 VEHICLES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 42-6-102. "Off-highway vehicle" does
13 not include the following:

14 (c) ~~Military vehicles;~~

15 **SECTION 3. Appropriation.** For the 2019-20 state fiscal year,
16 \$45,000 is appropriated to the department of revenue for use by the
17 division of motor vehicles. This appropriation is from the Colorado
18 DRIVES vehicle services account in the highway users tax fund created
19 in section 42-1-211 (2)(b)(I), C.R.S. To implement this act, the division
20 may use this appropriation for DRIVES maintenance and support.

21 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
22 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."

24 Page 1 of the bill, line 101, strike "**DEMILITARIZED MOTOR**" and
25 substitute "**SURPLUS MILITARY**".

26 Page 1 of the bill, line 102, strike "**HIGHWAY.**" and substitute "**HIGHWAY,**
27 **AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**".
