Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB19-073 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend the Health and Human Services Committee Report, dated
2 February 6, 2019, page 4, after line 5 insert:

3 **"SECTION 2. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal
4 year, \$993,147 is appropriated to the department of public health and
5 environment. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement
6 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:

7 (a) \$32,100 for use by the center for health and environmental
8 information for personal services related to health statistics and vital
9 records, which amount is based on an assumption that the center will
10 require an additional 0.5 FTE;

11 (b) \$211,047 for use by the center for health and environmental
12 information for operating expenses related to health statistics and vital
13 records; and

14 (c) \$750,000 for the purchase of information technology services.

15 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$750,000 is appropriated to
16 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
17 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
18 department of public health and environment under subsection (1)(c) of
19 this section. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation
20 to provide information technology services for the department of public
21 health and environment."
