Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB19-133 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Senate Health and Human Services Committee Report, dated  
2 February 21, 2019, page 11, after line 15 insert:

3 **"SECTION 10. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal  
4 year, \$33,622 is appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies.  
5 This appropriation is from the division of professions and occupations  
6 cash fund created in section 24-34-105 (2)(b)(I), C.R.S. To implement  
7 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:

8 (a) \$13,374 for use by the division of professions and occupations  
9 for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the  
10 division will require an additional 0.2 FTE;

11 (b) \$4,703 for use by the division of professions and occupations  
12 for operating expenses; and

13 (c) \$15,545 for use by the executive director's office and  
14 administrative services for the purchase of legal services.

15 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$15,545 is appropriated to  
16 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
17 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection  
18 (1)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department  
19 of law will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the  
20 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for  
21 the department of regulatory agencies."

22 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
