14 INPATIENT COMPETENCY RESTORATION AND WHO ARE WAITING ADMISSION
15 FOR AN INPATIENT BED. THIS SECTION DOES NOT TOLL OR OTHERWISE
16 MODIFY THE TIME FRAMES FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO OFFER INPATIENT
17 ADMISSION PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 16-8.5-111.

18 **SECTION 21. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal
19 year, \$10,983,000 is appropriated to the department of human services for
20 use by the office of behavioral health. This appropriation is from the
21 general fund. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation
22 as follows:

23 (a) \$10,483,000 for fines, liquidated damages, costs, or attorney
24 fees for non-compliance with the consent decree from the center for legal
25 advocacy v. Barnes case; and

26 (b) \$500,000 for compensation for the special master pursuant to
27 the consent decree from the center for legal advocacy v. Barnes case.

28 Any money appropriated in this section not expended prior to July
29 1, 2019, is further appropriated to the office for the 2019-20 state fiscal
30 year for the same purpose.

31 **SECTION 22. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal
32 year, \$8,141,194 is appropriated to the department of human services.
33 This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the
34 department may use this appropriation as follows:

18 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$139,901 is appropriated to
19 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
20 received from the department of human services under subsection (1) of
21 this section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will
22 require an additional 0.8 FTE. To implement this act, the department of
23 law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the
24 department of human services.

25 (3) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$50,000 is appropriated to
26 the department of law. This appropriation is from the general fund. To
27 implement this act, the department of law may use this appropriation to
28 allocate funds to the statewide organization representing district attorneys
29 for the public purpose of providing prosecution training pursuant to
30 section 20-1-111 (4)(c), C.R.S.

31 (4) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$454,539 is appropriated to
32 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
33 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
34 department of human services under subsection (1) of this section and is
35 based on an assumption that the office of information technology will
36 require an additional 0.9 FTE. To implement this act, the office may use
37 this appropriation to provide information technology services for the
38 department of human services.

39 (5) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$750,570 is appropriated to
40 the judicial department. This appropriation is from the general fund. To
41 implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:
