After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB20-1072 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 5, strike lines 19 through 24 and substitute:

2 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-3.3-103, **add** (9)
3 as follows:

4 **23-3.3-103. Annual appropriations - repeal.** (9) (a) THE
5 PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION CONCERNING
6 APPROPRIATIONS FOR STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS
7 ARTICLE 3.3 DO NOT APPLY TO APPROPRIATIONS MADE FOR THE PURPOSE
8 OF CONDUCTING FEASIBILITY STUDIES AND PILOT PROGRAMS TO
9 INVESTIGATE EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES FOR WATER MANAGEMENT
10 PURSUANT TO SECTION 23-20-141.

11 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (9) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022.

12 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-18-308, **amend**
13 (1)(f); and **add** (1)(h) as follows:

14 **23-18-308. Fee-for-service contracts - limited purpose - repeal.**
15 (1) Subject to available appropriations, the department shall enter into
16 fee-for-service contracts for the following purposes:

17 (f) Providing services to maximize concurrent enrollment across
18 the community college system as provided in section 23-60-202.7; **and**

19 (h) THE CONDUCT OF FEASIBILITY STUDIES AND PILOT PROGRAMS
20 TO INVESTIGATE EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES FOR WATER MANAGEMENT
21 PURSUANT TO SECTION 23-20-141. THIS SUBSECTION (1)(h) IS REPEALED,
22 EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2022.

23 **SECTION 6. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2020-21 state fiscal

1 year, \$40,000 is appropriated to the department of higher education. This
2 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the
3 department may use this appropriation for the college opportunity fund
4 program to be used for limited purpose fee-for-service contracts with
5 state institutions.

6 (2) For the 2020-21 state fiscal year, \$40,000 is appropriated to
7 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from
8 reappropriated funds received from the limited purpose fee-for-service
9 contracts with state institutions under subsection (1) of this section. To
10 implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the
11 regents of the university of Colorado."

12 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

13 Page 6, line 9, strike "4" and substitute "6".
