31 **SECTION 3. Appropriation.** For the 2019-20 state fiscal year,
32 \$500,000 is appropriated to the department of human services. This

1 appropriation is from the care subfund in the general fund. To implement
2 this act, the department may use this appropriation for a grant to the
3 Colorado 2-1-1 collaborative for eligible services. Any money
4 appropriated in this section not expended prior to July 1, 2020, is further
5 appropriated to the department for the period from July 1, 2020, through
6 December 30, 2020."
