Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB20-1415 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 11, after line 6 insert:
- 2           **"8-14.4-109. Repeal.** This article 14.4 is repealed, effective July  
3 1, 2022.
- 4           **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-77-109, **add**  
5 (2)(a)(II)(C) as follows:
- 6           **8-77-109. Employment support fund - employment and**  
7 **training technology fund - created - uses.** (2) (a) The state treasurer  
8 shall credit the moneys collected pursuant to this section to the  
9 employment support fund created in subsection (1) of this section. The  
10 general assembly shall appropriate the moneys in the employment support  
11 fund annually to the department of labor and employment:
- 12           (II) (C) (i) TO FUND THE ADMINISTRATION OF ARTICLE 14.4 OF THIS  
13 TITLE 8.
- 14           (ii) THIS SUBSECTION (2)(a)(II)(C) is repealed, effective July 1,  
15 2022.
- 16           **SECTION 3. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2020-21 state fiscal  
17 year, \$270,153 is appropriated to the department of labor and  
18 employment. This appropriation is from the employment support fund  
19 created in section 8-77-109 (1)(b), C.R.S. To implement this act, the  
20 department may use this appropriation as follows:
- 21           (a) \$206,193 for use by for use by the division of labor standards  
22 and statistics for enforcement of workers' rights related to a public health  
23 emergency, which amount is based on an assumption that the division will

1 require an additional 2.5 FTE; and  
2 (b) \$63,960 for the purchase of legal services.  
3 (2) For the 2020-21 state fiscal year, \$63,960 is appropriated to  
4 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
5 received from the department of labor and employment under subsection  
6 (1)(b) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department  
7 of law will require an additional 0.3 FTE. To implement this act, the  
8 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for  
9 the department of labor and employment."

10 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

11 Page 1, line 103, strike "EMERGENCY." and substitute "EMERGENCY,  
12 AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."

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
