	HB20-1425 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
1 2	Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and substitute:
3	"SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 25-3-124 as

5	25-3-124. Patient visitation rights during COVID-19 -
6	legislative declaration - definition - repeal. (1) The General
7	ASSEMBLY HEREBY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT:
8	(a) THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC HAS PRODUCED CHALLENGES TO
9	THE HEALTH CARE SYSTEMS IN COLORADO;
0	(b) HOSPITALS HAVE MADE MANY EFFORTS TO KEEP PATIENTS AND
1	EMPLOYEES IN A SAFE ENVIRONMENT AND HAVE ENDEAVORED TO
2	MINIMIZE, TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, THE RISK OF SPREADING COVID-19;
3	(c) As a result of measures to prevent the spread of
4	COVID-19, HOSPITALS HAVE INSTITUTED POLICIES THAT LIMIT PATIENTS'
5	ABILITY TO BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT WITH THEIR LOVED ONES DURING
6	THEIR HOSPITALIZATION AND TREATMENT;
7	(d) Many patients not diagnosed with COVID-19 have
8	THEREFORE BEEN ALONE DURING THEIR TREATMENT FOR SERIOUS
9	CONDITIONS, TRAUMAS, ILLNESSES, HEART ATTACKS, AND ROUTINE AND
20	EMERGENCY SURGERIES; AND
21	(e) IN ORDER TO BALANCE THE NEED TO REDUCE VIRUS
22 23	TRANSMISSION WITH THE BENEFITS OF HAVING FAMILY MEMBERS PRESENT
.5	DURING ILLNESS, ESPECIALLY AT THE END OF LIFE, AS KNOWLEDGE OF

COVID-19 ADVANCES, HOSPITALS ARE ENCOURAGED TO FOLLOW INFECTION PREVENTION PROTOCOLS AND IDENTIFY WAYS TO IMPROVE VISITATION POLICIES WHILE STILL FOLLOWING BEST PRACTICES.

- (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES, "COVID-19" MEANS THE RESPIRATORY ILLNESS CAUSED BY SEVERE ACUTE RESPIRATORY SYNDROME CORONAVIRUS 2, OR SARS-COV-2.
- 8 (3) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 30, 2021.
  9 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
  10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
  11 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.".
