CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE
GENERAL FUND TO THE STATE EDUCATION FUND.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-220, **add** (6)(a.5) as follows:

24-75-220. State education fund - transfers - surplus - legislative declaration - repeal. (6) (a.5) ON JULY 1, 2021, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STATE EDUCATION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 17 (4) OF ARTICLE IX

OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.


