SENATE BILL 21-222

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE STATE RECOVERY AUDIT PROGRAM, AND,
IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REDUCING AN APPROPRIATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-30-203.5, **add** (10)
as follows:

**24-30-203.5. Recovery audits - legislative declaration -
contracting - reporting - definitions - repeal.** (10) THIS SECTION IS
REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022.

SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments to 2021 long bill. To
implement this act, the general fund appropriation made in the annual
general appropriation act for the 2021-22 state fiscal year to the department
of personnel for use by financial operations and reporting for personal
services is decreased by \$64,714, and the related FTE is decreased by 1.0
FTE.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.




