After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB21-1012 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Finance with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 16, strike "individuals." and substitute
2 "individuals; EXCEPT THAT A VETERINARIAN LICENSED PURSUANT TO
3 ARTICLE 315 OF THIS TITLE 12 SHALL DISCLOSE SUCH INFORMATION ONLY
4 FOR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES."

5 Page 3, strike lines 15 through 27.

6 Page 4, strike lines 1 through 3 and substitute "(1) as follows:

7 **12-280-405. Prescription drug monitoring fund - creation -**
8 **gifts, grants, and donations - report - fee.** (1) The board ~~may~~ SHALL
9 seek and accept money from any public or private entity for the purposes
10 of implementing and maintaining the program. The board shall transmit
11 any money it receives to the state treasurer, who shall credit the money to
12 the prescription drug monitoring fund, which fund is hereby created. The
13 money in the fund is subject to annual appropriation by the general
14 assembly for the sole purpose of implementing and maintaining the
15 program. The money in the fund must not be transferred to or revert to the
16 general fund at the end of any fiscal year."

17 Page 4, line 4, strike "12-280-407, **amend**" and substitute "**amend**
18 12-280-407 as follows:"

19 Page 4, strike line 5.

20 Page 4, strike line 7 and substitute "**responsibilities - liability.** (1) A



1 prescription drug outlet shall submit information in the manner required
2 by the board. THE BOARD SHALL NOT REQUIRE A PRESCRIPTION DRUG
3 OUTLET TO SUBMIT INFORMATION FOR DRUGS PRESCRIBED BY A
4 VETERINARIAN LICENSED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 315 OF THIS TITLE 12
5 OTHER THAN INFORMATION CONCERNING PRESCRIPTIONS FOR CONTROLLED
6 SUBSTANCES.

7 (2) A practitioner who has, in good faith,".

8 Page 4, strike lines 13 through 27.

9 Page 5, strike lines 1 through 5 and substitute:

10 "SECTION 5. **Effective date.** (1) This act takes effect July 1,
11 2023, only if:

12 (a) Senate Bill 21-098 becomes law; and

13 (b) The executive director of the department of regulatory
14 agencies determines that there is sufficient money in the prescription drug
15 monitoring fund received pursuant to section 3 of this act from public and
16 private sources to fund the expansion of the electronic prescription drug
17 monitoring program to include all prescription drugs and the executive
18 director notifies the revisor of statutes of the receipt of such money by
19 e-mailing the notice to revisorofstatutes@state.co.us."
