After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB21-1283 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 4, strike "(3)(a)," and substitute "(3),  
2 (4)(c), (5)(a)," and after "(2.5)" insert "and (4)(d)".

4 Page 4, line 6, strike "ELEVEN" and substitute "FOURTEEN".

5 Page 4, strike lines 11 and 12 and substitute:

6 "(III) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR TO REPRESENT  
7 A TOWING ASSOCIATION WITHIN THE STATE WITH EXPERIENCE IN  
8 CONSENSUAL TOWING;

9 (IV) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR TO REPRESENT  
10 NONCONSENSUAL TOWING CARRIERS;"

11 Renumber succeeding subparagraphs accordingly.

12 Page 4, strike lines 15 and 16 and substitute:

13 "(VI) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR TO REPRESENT  
14 AN ASSOCIATION OF MOTOR CARRIERS WITHIN COLORADO AS CONSUMERS  
15 OF TOWING SERVICES;

16 (VII) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL WITH  
17 EXPERIENCE ENFORCING THE "COLORADO CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT",  
18 ARTICLE 1 OF TITLE 6;

19 (VIII) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR TO REPRESENT

1 PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES;".

2 Renumber succeeding subparagraphs accordingly.

3 Page 4, line 21, strike "UNIT OWNERS IN".

4 Page 5, line 15, strike "(2.5)(a)(V)" and substitute "(2.5)(a)(VII)".

5 Page 5, after line 16 insert:

6 "(b) The members shall elect a chair from among their  
7 membership. The chair shall set the times and frequency of the task  
8 force's meetings; EXCEPT THAT THE TASK FORCE SHALL MEET NO FEWER  
9 THAN TWO TIMES PER YEAR.

10 (4) (c) The commission ~~need not accept~~ SHALL CONSIDER the  
11 recommendations of the task force.

12 (d) (I) BY DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE COMMISSION SHALL  
13 MAKE A REPORT TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TRANSPORTATION  
14 AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
15 BUSINESS AFFAIRS AND LABOR COMMITTEE, THE SENATE BUSINESS, LABOR,  
16 AND TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE, AND THE SENATE TRANSPORTATION AND  
17 ENERGY COMMITTEE, OR ANY SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES. THE REPORT  
18 MUST:

19 (A) ADDRESS THE FEES CHARGED FOR AND COMPLAINTS ARISING  
20 FROM NONCONSENSUAL TOWS;

21 (B) CONTAIN THE RECOMMENDATIONS, INCLUDING RULE CHANGES,  
22 OF THE TASK FORCE, WHETHER THE RECOMMENDATIONS WERE  
23 IMPLEMENTED WITH OR WITHOUT MODIFICATION, AND AN ANALYSIS OF  
24 THE REASONS WHY THE COMMISSION MADE THESE DECISIONS.

25 (II) THIS SUBSECTION (4)(d) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026.

26 (5) The task force has the following duties and powers:

27 (a) To make comprehensive recommendations to the commission  
28 about the maximum rates that may be charged for the recovery, towing,  
29 and storage of a vehicle that has been towed without the owner's consent.  
30 The task force shall make ~~its first~~ comprehensive recommendations to the  
31 commission about the maximum rates ~~by~~ AFTER JULY 1, 2022, BUT NO  
32 LATER THAN September 1, ~~2015~~ 2022."

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
