Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB21-1304 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 36, after line 15 insert:

2 "SECTION 10. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2021-22 state fiscal  
3 year, \$587,500 is appropriated to the office of the governor. This  
4 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the office  
5 may use this appropriation as follows:

6 (a) \$225,560 for the administration of the governor's office and  
7 residence, which amount is based on an assumption that the office will  
8 require an additional 1.8 FTE;

9 (b) \$170,528 for use by the office of information technology for  
10 enterprise solutions, which amount is based on an assumption that the  
11 office will require an additional 1.8 FTE; and

12 (c) \$191,412 for the purchase of legal services.

13 (2) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$191,412 is appropriated to  
14 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
15 received from the governor's office under subsection (1)(c) of this section  
16 and is based on an assumption that the department of law will require an  
17 additional 1.0 FTE. To implement this act, the department of law may use  
18 this appropriation to provide legal services for the office of the governor.

19 (3) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$267,161 is appropriated to  
20 the department of human services for use by the office of early childhood.  
21 This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the  
22 office may use this appropriation as follows:

23 (a) \$108,521 for child care licensing and administration, which

1 amount is based on an assumption that the office will require an  
2 additional 1.2 FTE; and

3 (b) \$158,640 for continuation of child care quality initiatives.

4 (4) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$96,867 is appropriated to the  
5 department of education. This appropriation is from the general fund and  
6 is based on an assumption that the department will require an additional  
7 0.9 FTE. To implement this act, the department may use this  
8 appropriation for early childhood program transition."

9 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

10 Page 1, line 103, strike "CHILDHOOD." and substitute "CHILDHOOD AND  
11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."

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
