After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB21-101 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 6, line 5, after "(1)(g)" insert "and (1)(h)".

2 Page 6, after line 12 insert:

3 "(h) TO ORDER THE PHYSICAL OR MENTAL EXAMINATION OF A
4 DIRECT-ENTRY MIDWIFE IF THE DIRECTOR HAS REASONABLE CAUSE TO
5 BELIEVE THAT THE DIRECT-ENTRY MIDWIFE IS SUBJECT TO A PHYSICAL OR
6 MENTAL DISABILITY THAT RENDERS THE DIRECT-ENTRY MIDWIFE UNABLE
7 TO TREAT PATIENTS WITH REASONABLE SKILL AND SAFETY OR THAT MAY
8 ENDANGER A PATIENT'S HEALTH OR SAFETY. THE DIRECTOR MAY ORDER
9 A PHYSICAL OR MENTAL EXAMINATION REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THERE
10 IS INJURY TO A PATIENT."

11 "SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-2-112, **amend**
12 (7) as follows:

13 **25-2-112. Certificates of birth - filing - establishment of**
14 **paternity - notice to collegeinvest.** (7) The state registrar shall revise the
15 birth certificate worksheet form used for the preparation of a certificate
16 of live birth to include:

17 (a) A statement that knowingly and intentionally misrepresenting
18 material information on the worksheet form used for the preparation of
19 a birth certificate is a misdemeanor; AND

20 (b) A REQUIREMENT TO REPORT WHETHER THE LIVE BIRTH
21 OCCURRED AFTER A TRANSFER TO A HOSPITAL BY A DIRECT-ENTRY

- 1 MIDWIFE REGISTERED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 225 OF TITLE 12."
