Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB21-131 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 11, after line 13 insert:

2 "SECTION 4. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2021-22 state fiscal
3 year, \$45,890 is appropriated to the department of labor and employment
4 for use by the division of unemployment insurance. This appropriation is
5 from the employment support fund created in section 8-77-109 (1)(b)(I),
6 C.R.S., and is based on an assumption that the division will require an
7 additional 0.3 FTE. To implement this act, the division may use this
8 appropriation for program costs.

9 (2) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$14,053 is appropriated to
10 the department of human services. This appropriation consists of \$5,000
11 from the general fund and \$9,053 from the records and reports fund
12 created in section 19-1-307 (2.5)(b), C.R.S. To implement this act, the
13 department may use this appropriation as follows:

14 (a) \$5,000 from the general fund for adult protective services; and

15 (b) \$9,053 from the records and reports fund for use by the
16 executive director's office for the administrative review unit, which
17 amount is based on an assumption that the unit will require an additional
18 0.1 FTE.

19 (3) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$3,393 is appropriated to the
20 department of personnel for use by the Colorado state archives. This
21 appropriation is from the general fund, and is based on an assumption that
22 the state archives will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this
23 act, the state archives may use this appropriation for personal services."
