Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

- <u>SB21-175</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
- 1 Amend printed bill, page 27, strike lines 24 through 26.
- 2 Renumber succeeding subsection accordingly.
- 3 Page 28, before line 3 insert:

4 "(5) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION TO THE
5 CONTRARY, A CARRIER OR STATE AGENCY THAT IS REQUIRED PURSUANT
6 TO STATE OR FEDERAL LAW TO PURCHASE OR REIMBURSE A PAYER FOR A
7 PRESCRIPTION DRUG FOR WHICH THE BOARD HAS ESTABLISHED AN UPPER
8 PAYMENT LIMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 10-16-1307 IS NOT SUBJECT TO AN
9 ENFORCEMENT ACTION FOR A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1) OR (2) OF THIS
10 SECTION FOR THAT PARTICULAR PRESCRIPTION DRUG.".

11 Page 30, after line 20 insert:

"SECTION 4. Appropriation. (1) For the 2021-22 state fiscal
year, \$680,711 is appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies.
This appropriation is from the division of insurance cash fund created in
section 10-1-103 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may
use this appropriation as follows:

(a) \$275,297 for use by the division of insurance for personal
services, which amount is based on an assumption that the division will
require an additional 3.0 FTE;



1 (b) \$22,650 for use by the division of insurance for operating 2 expenses; and 3

(c) \$382,824 for the purchase of legal services.

(2) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$382,824 is appropriated to 4 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds 5 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection 6 (1)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department 7 of law will require an additional 2.0 FTE. To implement this act, the 8 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for 9 the department of regulatory agencies.". 10

- 11 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 12 Page 1, line 108, strike "AND".
- Page 1, line 109, strike "VIOLATIONS." and substitute "VIOLATIONS; AND 13
- 14 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."

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
