After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1102 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, line 8, after "(a)" insert "(I)".

2 Page 4, after line 1 insert:

3 "(II) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION (1)(a) PROHIBITS A WRITTEN OR
4 ORAL INQUIRY OR RECORD CONCERNING MILITARY OR VETERAN STATUS
5 WHEN THE PURPOSE OF THE INQUIRY OR RECORD IS TO DETERMINE A
6 PERSON'S ELIGIBILITY FOR VETERAN OR MILITARY HOUSING OR FOR A
7 VETERAN OR MILITARY HOUSING BENEFIT."

8 Page 4, line 18, after "(d)" insert "(I)".

9 Page 4, after line 24 insert:

10 "(II) THIS SUBSECTION (1)(d) DOES NOT APPLY WHEN THE PURPOSE
11 OF THE NOTICE OR ADVERTISEMENT IS TO PROMOTE VETERAN OR MILITARY
12 HOUSING OR A VETERAN OR MILITARY HOUSING BENEFIT."

13 page 6, line 8, after "(10)" insert "(a)".

14 Page 6, line 8, after "(10)" insert "(a)".

15 Page 6, line 9, strike "NON-DISCRIMINATORY" and substitute
16 "NONDISCRIMINATORY".

17 Page 6, after line 10 insert:

18 "(b) NOTHING IN THIS PART 5 PROHIBITS ADHERENCE TO

1 REQUIREMENTS UNDER 38 CFR 36 THAT GOVERN THE UNITED STATES
2 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS BENEFITS, INCLUDING RESTRICTIONS
3 ON OPTIONS ON A HOME CONTRACT, OR PROHIBITS INQUIRY REGARDING AN
4 INDIVIDUAL'S VETERAN OR MILITARY STATUS TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY
5 TO DETERMINE IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE FOR A BENEFIT OFFERED TO
6 VETERANS OR MEMBERS OF THE MILITARY. SUCH ADHERENCE DOES NOT
7 CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THIS PART 5."
