Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1230 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Business Affairs and Labor Committee Report, dated March
2 17, 2022, page 1, strike lines 1 through 6 and substitute:

3 "Amend printed bill, page 5, line 23, strike "(1)(a), (1)(c)," and substitute
4 "(1)(a)".

5 Page 6 of the bill, line 4, strike "FIVE HUNDRED" and substitute "TWO
6 HUNDRED FIFTY".

7 Page 6 of the bill, strike lines 8 through 13."

8 Page 1 of the report, after line 10 insert:

9 "Page 6 of the bill, before line 24 insert:

10 **"SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal
11 year, \$250,000 is appropriated to the employment support and job
12 retention services program cash fund created in section 8-83-406 (1)(a),
13 C.R.S. This appropriation is from the general fund. The department of
14 labor and employment is responsible for the accounting related to this
15 appropriation.

16 (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$250,000 is appropriated to
17 the department of labor and employment for use by the division of
18 employment and training. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
19 in the employment support and job retention services program cash fund
20 under subsection (1) of this section. To implement this act, the
21 department may use the appropriation for employment support and job
22 retention services."

- 2 Page 1 of the bill, line 102 strike "**PROGRAM.**" and substitute "**PROGRAM,**
- 3 **AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**".

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
