

1 (2) THE OFFICE SHALL:
2 (a) COORDINATE THE COLLECTION OF SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST
3 DATA INTO A DATA ANALYSIS SYSTEM SPECIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT,
4 INCLUDING OUTCOME DATA FROM HOSPITALS THAT RECEIVE CARDIAC
5 PATIENTS TRANSPORTED BY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES;
6 (b) IMPLEMENT AN OUTREACH CAMPAIGN TO:
7 (I) RAISE AWARENESS REGARDING SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST AND
8 THE SKILLS NECESSARY TO SAVE LIVES, INCLUDING THE IMPORTANCE OF
9 COMPRESSION CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION;
10 (II) RAISE AWARENESS REGARDING THE USE OF PUBLIC ACCESS
11 DEFIBRILLATORS;
12 (III) DEMONSTRATE HOW TO CALL FOR HELP AND EMERGENCY
13 MEDICAL SERVICES; AND
14 (IV) ENCOURAGE ALL RESIDENTS OF COLORADO TO ENGAGE IN
15 BASIC LIFE-SAVING ACTIONS;
16 (c) MAINTAIN A LIST OF TRAINING AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS
17 OFFERED IN THE STATE THAT:
18 (I) TEACH LIFE-SAVING SKILLS, INCLUDING CARDIOPULMONARY
19 RESUSCITATION AND THE USE OF A DEFIBRILLATOR; AND
20 (II) COMPLY WITH THE GUIDELINES PUBLISHED BY THE AMERICAN
21 HEART ASSOCIATION;
22 (d) EMPLOY A STATEWIDE CARDIAC ARREST DATA COORDINATOR
23 AND OTHER PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSES OF
24 THIS SECTION; AND
25 (e) COORDINATE THE SUBMISSION OF DATA, INCLUDING THE
26 GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM LOCATION OF PUBLIC ACCESS
27 DEFIBRILLATORS TO AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR REGISTRY
28 DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
29 (3) THE OFFICE MAY:
30 (a) ACQUIRE, ANALYZE, AND OVERSEE CARDIAC ARREST DATA;
31 (b) RELEASE REPORTS GENERATED FROM THE DATA; AND
32 (c) SHARE THE DATA WITH:
33 (I) EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDERS, DISPATCH
34 CENTERS, HOSPITALS, AND OTHER ENTITIES AS APPROPRIATE TO ASSIST
35 WITH EMERGENCY RESPONSE CAPABILITIES;
36 (II) APPROPRIATE ENTITIES AS REQUESTED FOR RESEARCH
37 PURPOSES;
38 (III) DESIGNATED STATE AND NATIONAL CARDIAC ARREST
39 REGISTRIES; AND
40 (IV) DESIGNATED STATE AND NATIONAL AUTOMATED EXTERNAL
41 DEFIBRILLATOR REGISTRIES.
42 (4) (a) FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23, AND FOR EACH STATE
43 FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL APPROPRIATE

1 TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE
2 DEPARTMENT FOR ALLOCATION TO THE OFFICE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS
3 SECTION.

4 (b) THE DEPARTMENT MAY SEEK, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND GIFTS,
5 GRANTS, AND DONATIONS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.

6 (5) THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH MAY PROMULGATE RULES TO
7 IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.

8 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
9 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
10 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
11 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
12 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
13 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
14 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
15 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
16 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."

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
