Committee on Judiciary.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1353 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 4, line 18, strike "**creation.**" and substitute
2 "**public safety communications revolving fund - creation. (1)**".

3 Page 4, after line 24 insert:

4 "(2) (a) THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS REVOLVING FUND,
5 REFERRED TO IN THIS SECTION AS THE "FUND", IS HEREBY CREATED IN THE
6 STATE TREASURY. THE FUND CONSISTS OF MONEY APPROPRIATED TO THE
7 FUND PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2)(b) OF THIS SECTION, MONEY
8 DEPOSITED OR CREDITED TO THE FUND PURSUANT TO SUBSECTIONS (3) AND
9 (4) OF THIS SECTION, AND ANY OTHER MONEY THAT THE GENERAL
10 ASSEMBLY MAY TRANSFER TO THE FUND.

11 (b) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL APPROPRIATE MONEY TO THE
12 FUND EACH FISCAL YEAR IN THE ANNUAL GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT
13 FOR THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF THE OFFICE.

14 (c) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL INTEREST AND
15 INCOME DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT OR INVESTMENT OF MONEY IN THE
16 FUND TO THE FUND.

17 (d) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ANY UNEXPENDED AND
18 UNENCUMBERED MONEY REMAINING IN THE FUND AT THE END OF A FISCAL
19 YEAR TO THE FUND.

20 (e) MONEY IN THE FUND IS CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED TO THE
21 OFFICE TO PAY THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS, INCLUDING PERSONAL
22 SERVICES AND OPERATING COSTS, ASSOCIATED WITH ADMINISTERING
23 PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS.

24 (3) THE OFFICE SHALL DEVELOP A METHOD FOR BILLING USERS OF
25 THE OFFICE'S SERVICES THE FULL COST OF THE SERVICES, INCLUDING
26 MATERIALS, DEPRECIATION RELATED TO CAPITAL COSTS, LABOR, AND

1 ADMINISTRATIVE OVERHEAD. THE BILLING METHOD SHALL BE FULLY
2 IMPLEMENTED FOR ALL USERS OF THE OFFICE'S SERVICES ON OR BEFORE
3 JULY 1, 2023. REVENUE GENERATED FROM SUCH BILLING SHALL BE
4 CREDITED TO THE FUND.

5 (4) (a) THE OFFICE MAY SEEK, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND GIFTS,
6 GRANTS, DONATIONS, AND BEQUESTS FROM PRIVATE OR PUBLIC SOURCES
7 FOR THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS, INCLUDING PERSONAL SERVICES
8 AND OPERATING COSTS, ASSOCIATED WITH ADMINISTERING PUBLIC SAFETY
9 COMMUNICATIONS. THE OFFICE SHALL TRANSMIT ALL MONEY RECEIVED
10 THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, DONATIONS, OR BEQUESTS FOR SUCH PURPOSES
11 TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE MONEY TO THE FUND.

12 (b) THE OFFICE MAY CONTRACT WITH THE UNITED STATES AND
13 ANY OTHER LEGAL ENTITIES WITH RESPECT TO MONEY AVAILABLE TO THE
14 OFFICE THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, DONATIONS, OR BEQUESTS."

15 Page 16, strike lines 6 and 7 and substitute:

16 "(3) (a) (I) FOR THE 2023-24 AND 2024-25 STATE FISCAL YEARS,
17 THE".

18 Page 16, strike lines 17 and 18 and substitute:

19 "(II) FOR THE 2023-24 AND 2024-25 STATE FISCAL YEARS, IN
20 ADDITION TO".

21 Page 19, after line 16 insert:

22 "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-37.5-501, add
23 (3) as follows:

24 **24-37.5-501. Powers, duties, and functions concerning**
25 **telecommunications.** (3) THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER SHALL BEGIN
26 THE TRANSFER OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROGRAM
27 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY PURSUANT TO HOUSE BILL
28 22-1353 ON JULY 1, 2022."

29 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

30 Page 21, after line 26 insert:

31 "SECTION 11. **Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2023;
32 except that sections 3, 11, and 12 of this act take effect upon passage."

33 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

- 1 Strike "2022" and substitute "2023" on: **Page 4**, line 26; **Page 5**, lines 6
- 2 and 22; **Page 6**, lines 8 and 21; **Page 12**, line 26; and **Page 17**, line 6.

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
