Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB22-097 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, after line 17 insert:

2 "SECTION 2. Appropriation. (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal
3 year, \$417,629 is appropriated to the department of labor and
4 employment. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement
5 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:

6 (a) \$386,579 for use by the division of labor standards and
7 statistics for program costs related to labor standards, which amount is
8 based on an assumption that the subdivision will require an additional 4.3
9 FTE; and

10 (b) \$31,050 for the purchase of legal services.

11 (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$228,499 is appropriated to
12 the department of personnel. This appropriation is from the general fund.
13 To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as
14 follows:

15 (a) \$125,000 for use by the division of human resources for
16 liability claims; and

17 (b) \$103,499 for the purchase of legal services.

18 (3) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$134,549 is appropriated to
19 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
20 received from the department of labor and employment under subsection
21 (1)(b) of this section and from the department of personnel under
22 subsection (2)(b) of this section and is based on an assumption that the
23 department of law will require an additional 0.8 FTE. To implement this
24 act, the department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal
25 services for the department of labor and employment and the department
26 of personnel."
