After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
SB22-230 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 36, after line 6 insert:
"SECTION 3. Appropriation. (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$480,753 is appropriated to the department of labor and employment. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows: (a) \$303,327 for use by division of labor standards and statistics for program costs related to labor standards, which amount is based on an assumption that the subdivision will require an additional 3.0 FTE; and (b) \$177,426 for the purchase of legal services. (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$177,426 is appropriated to the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the department of labor and employment under subsection (1)(b) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will require an additional 1.0 FTE. To implement this act, the department of labor and employment."
Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
Page 1, line 102, strike "BARGAINING." and substitute "BARGAINING, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.".
