 - 27-60-109. Youth mental health services program established report rules definitions. (1) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - (b) "Program" means the temporary youth mental health services program established in this section.
 - (2) (a) There is established in the behavioral health administration the temporary youth mental health services program to facilitate access to mental health services, including substance use disorder services, for youth to respond to mental health needs identified in an initial mental health screening through the portal, including those needs that may have resulted from the COVID-19 pandemic. The program reimburses providers for up to three mental health sessions with a youth.
 - (5.5) (c) This subsection (5.5) is repealed, effective June 30, 2024.
 - (d) FOR THE 2024-25 STATE FISCAL YEAR AND EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL APPROPRIATE MONEY TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION. THE STATE DEPARTMENT MAY SEEK, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS FROM ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RESOURCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION.
 - (6) This section is repealed, effective June 30, 2024.
- SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 27-50-105, amend (1)(g) as follows:
 - 27-50-105. Administration of behavioral health programs state plan sole mental health authority. (1) The BHA shall administer and provide the following behavioral health programs and services:
