After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
HB23-1117 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 2 and 3 and substitute:
"SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. (1) The general assembly finds and declares that:  (a) Colorado is home to more than half a million immigrants including refugees, who make up ten percent of the state's population and play a vital role in our state's cultural fabric and shared prosperity;  (b) People who are lawful permanent residents and receive public benefits are currently prohibited from sponsoring individuals, usually family members, from coming to the United States, leading to unnecessary family separation;  (c) Lawful permanent residents are treated differently under current Colorado law than United States citizens who are allowed to be a sponsor for immigrants; and  (d) Only United States citizens and lawful permanent residents can provide sponsorship for individuals who want to immigrate to the United States. Lawful permanent residents do not include undocumented immigrants who are ineligible for most federal benefits.  SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 25.5-3-105 as follows:"
Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

- Page 2, line 17, after the period add: "THE COUNTY DEPARTMENTS
- RESPONSIBLE FOR ADMINISTERING BENEFITS PROGRAMS UNDER THE
- DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE POLICY AND FINANCING AND THE
- DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES SHALL IDENTIFY AND REVIEW ALL
- CURRENT COUNTY GUIDANCE MATERIALS, INCLUDING FORMS, TRAINING

- 1 MATERIALS, WEBSITES, AND ANY OTHER MATERIALS THAT REFERENCE A

- 6 Page 2, strike lines 18 and 19 and substitute:
- 7 "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-5-101, repeal
- 8 (3); and **add** (5) as follows:".
- 9 Page 3, after line 6, insert:
- 10 "(5) The county departments responsible for
- 11 ADMINISTERING BENEFITS PROGRAMS UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
- 12 CARE POLICY AND FINANCING AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES
- 13 SHALL IDENTIFY AND REVIEW ALL CURRENT COUNTY GUIDANCE
- 14 MATERIALS, INCLUDING FORMS, TRAINING MATERIALS, WEBSITES, AND

- 20 Page 3, strike lines 7 and 8 and substitute:
- "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 26-2-111.8, repeal
- 22 (5); and **add** (5.5) as follows:"
- Page 3, after line 18, insert:
- 24 "(5.5) The county departments responsible for
- 25 ADMINISTERING BENEFITS PROGRAMS UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
- 26 CARE POLICY AND FINANCING AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES
- 27 SHALL IDENTIFY AND REVIEW ALL CURRENT COUNTY GUIDANCE
- 28 MATERIALS, INCLUDING FORMS, TRAINING MATERIALS, WEBSITES, AND
- 29 ANY OTHER MATERIALS THAT REFERENCE A PROHIBITION ON SPONSORSHIP
- 30 AS A CONDITION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR BENEFITS AND SHALL REMOVE ALL
- 31 SUCH REFERENCES FROM VERBAL AND DIGITAL COMMUNICATIONS AND
- 32 FROM ALL PHYSICAL MATERIALS CURRENTLY PROVIDED TO APPLICANTS OR
- 33 BENEFICIARIES.".
