Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB23-111 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Local Government and Housing Committee Report, dated
2 February 28, 2023, page 1, after line 17 insert:

3 "Page 7 of the printed bill, strike lines 4 through 7 and substitute "OF THIS
4 ARTICLE 32 AND SHALL CREATE AND ADMINISTER A PROCESS TO ACCEPT
5 AND REVIEW COMPLAINTS AND TO INVESTIGATE COMPLAINTS OR OTHER
6 LEADS CONCERNING A VIOLATION THAT, IN THE DIRECTOR'S GOOD FAITH
7 DISCRETION AND JUDGMENT, WARRANT INVESTIGATION. THE DIVISION
8 SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS
9 ARTICLE 32."

10 Page 1 of the report, line 19, strike "RETALIATION." and substitute
11 "RETALIATION, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN
12 APPROPRIATION."

13 Amend printed bill, page 7, after line 24 insert:

14 "(7) ANY FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO COVER THE DIVISION'S COSTS
15 RELATING TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ARTICLE 32 MUST BE FROM THE
16 GENERAL FUND."

17 Page 12 of the bill, after line 6 insert:

18 "**SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal
19 year, \$151,751 is appropriated to the department of labor and
20 employment. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement
21 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:

22 (a) \$94,651 for use by the division of labor standards and statistics

1 for program costs related to labor standards, which amount is based on an
2 assumption that the division will require an additional 0.9 FTE; and
3 (b) \$57,100 for the purchase of legal services.
4 (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$57,100 is appropriated to
5 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
6 received from the department of labor and employment under subsection
7 (1)(b) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department
8 of law will require an additional 0.3 FTE. To implement this act, the
9 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for
10 the department of labor and employment."

11 Page 12 of the bill, strike lines 7 through 15 and substitute:

12 **"SECTION 8. Act subject to petition - effective date.** Section
13 29-32-105 (3) of this act takes effect on July 1, 2024, and the remainder
14 of this act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration
15 of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly;
16 except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of
17 article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or
18 part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will
19 not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be
20 held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of
21 the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."

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
