"SECTION 14. Appropriation. (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$15,000,000 is appropriated to the housing plans assistance fund created in section 29-33-112 (3)(a), C.R.S. This appropriation is from the general fund. The department of local affairs is responsible for the accounting related to this appropriation.

- (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$15,000,000 is appropriated to the department of local affairs. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds from the housing plans assistance fund received under subsection (1) of this section. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:
- (a) \$65,992 for use by the state demography office for program costs, which amount is based on an assumption that the office will require an additional 0.6 FTE;
- (b) \$41,136 for use by the division of housing for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the office will require an additional 0.5 FTE;
- (c) \$4,010 general fund for use by the division of housing for operating expenses; and
- (d) \$14,888,862 for use by the division of local government for the local land use assistance program, which amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 10.4 FTE.
- (3) Any money appropriated in subsection (2) of this section not expended prior to July 1, 2024 is further appropriated for the 2024-25 and 2025-26 state fiscal years for the same purpose.
- (4) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$625,109 is appropriated to the department of natural resources. This appropriation consists of \$84,939 from the general fund and \$540,170 cash funds from the Colorado water conservation board construction fund created in section 37-60-121 (1)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:
- (a) \$76,919 general fund for use by the executive director's office for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the office will require an additional 1.0 FTE;
- (b) \$8,020 general fund for use by the executive director's office for operating expenses; and
- (c) \$540,170 from the Colorado water conservation board construction fund for use by the Colorado water conservation board for personal services.
 - (5) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$29,455 is appropriated to

the office of the governor for use by the Colorado energy office. This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that the office will require an additional 0.3 FTE. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation for program administration.

- (6) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$100,000 is appropriated to the office of the governor. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation for the office of climate preparedness.
- (7) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$53,896 is appropriated to legislative department. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:
- (a) \$26,492 for use by the legislative council, which amount is based on an assumption that the legislative council will require an additional 0.3 FTE;
- (b) \$17,202 for use by the committee on legal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the committee will require an additional 0.2 FTE; and
 - (c) \$10,202 for use by the general assembly.".
