Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB23-290 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 87, after line 19 insert:

2 "SECTION 40. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal
3 year, \$733,658 General Fund is appropriated to the department of
4 revenue. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation
5 as follows:

6 (a) \$536,826 for marijuana enforcement, which amount is based
7 on an assumption that the department will require an additional 4.7 FTE;

8 (b) \$6,500 for tax administration IT system (GenTax) support; and

9 (c) \$190,332 for the purchase of legal services.

10 (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$190,332 is appropriated to
11 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
12 received from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(c) of this
13 section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will
14 require an additional 1.0 FTE. To implement this act, the department of
15 law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the
16 department of revenue.

17 (3) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$101,150 is appropriated to
18 the department of law. This appropriation is from the legal services cash
19 fund created in section 24-31-108 (4), C.R.S., from revenue received
20 from the department of regulatory agencies that is continuously
21 appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies from the regulated
22 natural medicine access program fund created in section 12-170-106 (1),
23 C.R.S. The appropriation to the department of law is based on an
24 assumption that the department of law will require an additional 0.5 FTE.
25 To implement this act, the department of law may use this appropriation
26 to provide legal services for the department of regulatory agencies.

27 (4) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$838,402 General Fund is

1 appropriated to the department of public health and environment for use
2 by the division of disease control and public health response. This
3 appropriation is based on an assumption that division will require an
4 additional 4.1 FTE. To implement this act, the division may use this
5 appropriation for the natural medicine program related to laboratory
6 services."

7 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

8 Page 1, line 101, strike "MEDICINE." and substitute "MEDICINE, AND, IN
9 CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
