

# An Act

HOUSE BILL 24-1201

CONCERNING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1. Appropriation to the department of transportation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023.** In Session Laws of Colorado 2023, section 2 of chapter 474, (SB 23-214), **amend** Part XXII as follows:



109 Department of Transportation, Special Purpose, Multimodal Transportation Projects -- This appropriation remains available until the close of the 2026-27 state fiscal year.




