

HOUSE BILL 24-1419

BY REPRESENTATIVE(S) Bird and Taggart, Sirota, Valdez, Woodrow, McCluskie; also SENATOR(S) Bridges and Zenzinger, Priola.

CONCERNING A TRANSFER OF TEN MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE ENERGY AND CARBON MANAGEMENT CASH FUND TO THE STATIONARY SOURCES CONTROL FUND.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 34-60-122, **add** (5)(e) as follows:

34-60-122. Expenses - energy and carbon management cash fund created. (5) (e) On June 30, 2024, the state treasurer shall transfer ten million dollars from the energy and carbon management cash fund to the stationary sources control fund created in section 25-7-114.7 (2)(b)(I).

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-7-114.7, add (2)(b)(V) as follows:

Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material added to existing law; dashes through words or numbers indicate deletions from existing law and such material is not part of the act.

- 25-7-114.7. Emission fees fund rules definition. (2) (b) (V) IN ADDITION TO THE MONEY CREDITED OR TRANSFERRED TO THE STATIONARY SOURCES CONTROL FUND, THE FUND CONSISTS OF THE MONEY TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND FROM THE ENERGY AND CARBON MANAGEMENT CASH FUND PURSUANT TO SECTION 34-60-122 (5)(e).
- **SECTION 3.** Safety clause. The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for

the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state institutions.
